On Thursday, December 19th we will be presenting our Christmas program in the church at 6:00 P.M. Please arrive by 5:30 P.M. and drop your child off in their classroom. Religion

During our religion time, we have been learning about Elisha and Naaman. After the Israelites wandered in the wilderness for 40 years, they were given a new beginning. Biblical scholars will often refer to the crossing of the Jordan River as a Baptism of the children of Israel.

Many years later, John the Baptist called for a Baptism of repentance from the banks of the Jordan River, telling people to repent "for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Matthew 3:2). Before Jesus's ascension, the Baptism Jesus commanded (Matthew 28:19) was completely new. To baptize in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit is the way Baptisms have been done since the day of Pentecost (Acts 2).

Why Baptism? A sick Naaman had travelled to see Elisha to be healed. Yet he asked why he should wash in the Jordan River. God chose Baptism as the way our sins would be washed away, and we would have the promise of a new and eternal life in Him (Romans 6:1-11). We thank our Heavenly Father for this wonderful gift and that he chose two elements on earth such as oxygen and hydrogen plus His Word, to transform our lives with His saving love and grace.
