In the story of Ruth, we see a great declaration of love and loyalty from a woman towards her mother-in-law, Naomi. In one of the only books of the Bible written primarily about a woman Ruth says, "For where you go, I will go, and where you live, I will live. Your people shall be my people, and your God will be my God (Ruth 1:16)."

The main three characters in the story of Ruth have varying personalities as well. In Ruth we see, a poor young widow who loves with a steadfast love. In Naomi we see, a woman who was sad, worried, and afraid, she put the well-being of her daughters-in-law ahead of her own. In Boaz we see, a God-fearing man who follows the established rules, is responsible, and insists on paying the full price for his beloved.

Hannah and Samuel: Hannah is ridiculed by her husband's second wife Peninnah for being barren. Hannah prays fervently to God for a child, and finally, her request is granted with the promise that she will dedicate Samuel to God's service. Hannah shows us humility, patience, but also poise and prayer as she waits for God's response in His timing.
