### Religion

During our religion time, we have been learning  
about Jesus at the home of Mary and Martha.

This story shows us the importance of having  
Jesus as our first priority. Martha was not doing  
anything wrong in preparing for her Lord. She had  
just lost her focus on what was important. As  
Martha scurried around performing her tasks,  
Mary focused intently on Jesus. When Martha  
noticed Mary, she became frustrated and felt as if  
Mary was neglecting her duties to the Lord.  
Martha was direct—she did not go back to the  
kitchen to sulk, Martha went straight to her Lord!  
“Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me  
to serve alone? Tell her then to help me” (Luke  
10:40). Martha firmly believed that Jesus would  
see that she had done the right thing and that her  
sister, Mary, had done the wrong thing. At this  
point in the story, it is important to remember that  
Jesus loved Martha too. When Jesus answered  
Martha, He dealt first with her immediate needs.  
“Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled  
about many things” (Luke 10:41). Jesus gently let  
her know that He understood that she was upset.  
But then, He continued with “but one thing is  
necessary.” For a moment Martha had forgotten  
why she was serving and who was most  
important.
